



NCCP Introduction to Competition Canoe Kayak Coach - Online 2024

Welcome to your Competition Introduction Canoe Kayak coaching course! This course will be offered in a blended learning format for the 2024 season. Coach candidates will experience an enhanced learning experience, starting with a pre-course task. This task is available in the Google Classroom Assignments, and due for submission prior to May 14, 2024.

The online component of the course will take place on May 14, 15, 21, 22, and July 24, 2024. In this live, NCCP Learning Facilitator led, interactive course, you will be required to communicate and complete group work with other coaches. Throughout the workshop participants will use Google Meets and Google Classroom platforms. If you are having difficulties joining the Google Classroom you may need to use/create a Gmail account. Links to both Google Meets and Google Classroom will be provided in the registration confirmation email on Monday, May 13, 2024.

Following the May 22nd session, coach candidates will enter the second portion of the course. This will involve each coach fulfilling a set of practical tasks that will take place at their own Canoe Club. These tasks will allow the coach candidate to practice the skills that will be required during the Coach Evaluation. Competency in these tasks will be signed off by the Club Head Coach or a designate approved by the Learning Facilitator.

The July 24th online session will support the coach around their specific needs, and to answer any questions the coach candidate may have prior to the Evaluation.

After the July 24th online session, the coach candidate will then arrange their Practical Evaluation. A Practical Evaluation can be completed with a Certified Evaluator either in-person or remotely. Submission of the Coach Portfolio (EAP, Practice Plan, and Weekly Plan) must be completed and submitted prior to arranging the Practical Evaluation.

- NCCP Sport Nutrition
- NCCP Safe Sport
