



## Canoe Kayak Ontario (CKO) Sprint's 2019 Club & Coach Development Program (CCDP)

The CCDP was created to assist clubs in their delivery of programs through use of CKO Sprint equipment as well as provide enhanced professional development opportunities for their coaches.

### Equipment Support

Clubs will have the opportunity to apply to use CKO Sprint boats and equipment during the competitive season with exception of black-out dates, June 26<sup>th</sup> to July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

Priority will be determined based on the number of athletes on the Ontario Team; the number of participants at the 2019 Ontario Team Trials; whether the equipment will be used to support athletes on the Ontario Team; and the club's need for the equipment.

### Coach Support

The Coaching Excellence Mentoring Program is intended to provide a formal structure and resource to assist coaches in developing a personalized professional development pathway. It takes into consideration current knowledge, experience and interests of coaches as well as needs and demands of young athletes. The primary aim is to ensure that targeted coaches have all of the tools they need for them and their athletes to perform at their very best.

Specific program features include a focus on improving both structural and behavioral organizational effectiveness, increasing technical coaching expertise, and building competition event management skills. Benefits of the program to the coaches will include improved personal coaching competency and readiness for the advanced NCCP Coaching Education pathway.

Note - coach candidates must be NCCP Advanced Competition Introduction (ELCC) Trained or enrolled in the 2019 workshop.

### Application Process

Each project has been assigned a value in kind (VIK) amount ranging from \$1000 to \$2000 based on usage or time cost associated with the project. As a member of CKO Sprint, each

club may receive a maximum of \$2000 in VIK. Due to the nature of the application process it is suggested that clubs apply for multiple projects over the \$2000 VIK limit.
