Additional entries will only be provided if there is an open lane, no additional heats will be added.

The Competition Meeting for competition organizers, officials and coaches will be held before the competition to provide final competition details, and to confirm entries.

The competition will be run with modified International Canoe Federation (ICF) racing rules. A copy of the ICF racing rules can be found at www.canoeicf.com. Modified rules will be reviewed with the coaches during the Competition Meeting.

Boat weighing and supervised on-water training will be available between 2:00 pm - 5:00 pm on Friday, as well as 30 minutes before the first race each day.

Boat Numbers: CKO Sprint will not be responsible for providing boat numbers. Participating clubs and athletes will be responsible for providing their own regulation size boat numbers for Ontario Team Trials. Please note athletes who are missing or have an incorrect boat number for their event may be subject to a fine of \$25. Member clubs will be liable for their athlete's penalty.

Due to the number of entries and events, only singles events will be provided.

COVID-19 Requirements

All participants and spectators are strongly encouraged to observe physical distancing whenever possible.



Participant & Spectator Zones

Please see WIFC Site Map – Ontario Team Trials below to determine access areas.

Blue Zone – located around Colborne Rd is for participants and coaching staff. Washroom access will be provided in the lower level of the Athlete's building. A portable washroom will be located at the 250m mark. Spectators are only permitted to visit the area for a short duration.

Red Zone – located at the tower area is for officials, organizers, and volunteers only. Washrooms are available in the tower. Athletes, coaches, and spectators will not have access to the tower.

Purple Zone – located on Canal Bank St is for spectators. A portable washroom will be located within the Purple Zone. Spectators will also have access to the hill area north of Athlete's building and the washrooms located in the lower level of the Athlete's building.

Ontario Cup Series Points

Ontario Cup Series Grand Champion points consist of a combined clubs’ total points from all three (3) 2022 Ontario Cup events. The Excellence Award points combines a club’s total points from all three (3) 2022 Ontario Cup events, divided by the number of club participants in each event. Inter-club crew boat points will be divided between the clubs based on percentage of crew members per club.
